



AFL HUNTER COAST LIFE MEMBERSHIP POLICY

Process

- An AFL Hunter Coast Board Member, Hunter or Central Coast Regional Committee Member, or AFL Hunter Coast Member Club may propose a nomination for AFL Hunter Coast Life Membership.
- A nomination must be put in writing to the Secretary of the AFL Hunter Coast Board. The nomination process can be completed at any time.
- The AFL Hunter Coast Board must appoint the nomination.
- The Life Member must be presented at an AFL Hunter Coast function.

Criteria

- A nominee must not have any prior football related sanctions next to his/her name.
- A nominee must have:
 - Provided a minimum of 5 years of outstanding service within the AFL Hunter Coast, over and above the expectations of their position; or
 - Contributed to the AFL Hunter Coast in such a way that their contribution will leave a lasting legacy to the AFL Hunter Coast; or
 - Achieved a level of excellence within the AFL Hunter Coast, which sets him/her out from all others in his/her field.
- Life Members of past related Associations may be nominated for AFL Hunter Coast Life Membership, as determined by the AFL Hunter Coast Board.
